## **12.0 Polychlorinated Biphenyl Contamination**

A detailed description and overview map of the Ohio Valley Connector Expansion Project (Project) are provided in Resource Report 1, General Project Description.

Resource Report 12 is required for applications involving the replacement, abandonment by removal, or abandonment in place of facilities determined to have Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCBs) in excess of 50 parts per million in pipeline liquids. It also is required for compressor station modifications at sites known to have PCB--contaminated soils.

The Project will transport natural gas from Equitrans, L.P.'s (Equitrans) Mainline and Sunrise Transmission Systems and other gathering receipt points to interconnections with interstate pipelines operated by Rockies Express Pipeline and Rover Pipeline LLC. No PCBs are anticipated to be encountered during Project interconnections. Additionally, because the Project only includes new pipeline construction and does not involve the replacement, abandonment by removal, or abandonment in place of pipeline facilities with PCBs or compressor station modifications or removals on sites that have been determined to have soils contaminated with PCBs, Resource Report 12 is not required for the Project.
